Assuming continued employment through the end of fiscal 2022, any units earned will then vest in one installment and the shares will be issued shortly thereafter. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum number is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- 5. If the Company achieves certain goals over the 2018-2020 period, the performance units will vest and stock will be awarded. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- 6. If the Company achieves certain goals over the 2019-2021 period, the performance units will vest and stock will be awarded. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- 7. If the Company achieves certain goals over the 2020-2022 period, the performance units will vest and stock will be awarded. The target number of units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported, subject to plan limits.
- 8. Stock appreciation rights grant fully vested.
- 9. Original stock appreciation rights grant vests in three annual installments beginning on the date listed in the "Date Exercisable" column.
